WHY JOHN METCHIE III IS A DEEP SLEEPER FOR YOUR SPORTS CARD INVESTMENT PORTFOLIO

Welcome to summer, where football card investors are forecasting who the next breakout QB will be. While speculating these big name QB's is fun, there are several low-risk, high-reward little name guys in which you should invest. Despite the traditional QB only thinking, they are profits to be had from plenty of WRs, RBs, and even Defensive players.

My sneaky play of this NFL off-season is JOHN METCHIE III. I believe that Metchie is the safest play in the current football card world. Your worst case scenario should net you most all of your money back. Best case scenario could 5-10X your money. Here are a few likely hype cycles coming for Mr. Metchie, creating a buy now opportunity for this no name player.

- **1. METCHIE'S STORY WILL CREATE A HYPE SPIKE.** Let's face it, sports card collecting can be very emotional. Sports are emotional, fans are emotional, and sports card collectors are emotional. Some players are popular in the card community regardless of their play on the field. Think about Pat Tillman, a man who courageously gave up his NFL career, and ultimately his life, to serve his country. John Metchie's story is nothing short of incredible. Drafted by the Texans in the 2nd round of the 2022 NFL Draft, Metchie unexpectedly was diagnosed with leukemia which ended his rookie season before it began. Thankfully, he made a full recovery and is on schedule to make his NFL Debut in week 1. Here is the key: with so many pregame shows and sports news programming, it seems likely that one (or more) of the major networks will run a special highlighting his story. This sort of attention will create a well-deserved spike in sports card pricing. Everyone loves a feel good story, and a simple media story on Metchie will create a hype spike, regardless of play.
- 2. METCHIE COULD BE HOUSTON'S WR1. There isn't a whole lot of talent in the receiving room for the Houston Texans. The team brought in 31 year old free agent Robert Woods, who hasn't had an 1000 year receiving season since 2019. Nico Collins is entering his 3rd season, and hasn't reached 1000 yards in his career. The team also brought in free agent Noah Brown, who hasn't accumulated a total of 1000 yards in his 5 year career. The real threat to Metchie is recently drafted Tank Dell, who the Texans traded up to take in the 3rd round of this year's draft. Regardless, there are lots of snaps out there for Metchie. It is well within the realm of possibility that Metchie comes out as the WR1 in Houston.
- 3. CURRENT METCHIE PRICING PROVIDES A VERY LOW RISK PROPOSISTION. Out of the 2021 WR draft class, Metchie is currently selling in the bottom of the basement. He's currently selling in the same neighborhood as Wan'dale Robinson, Alec Pierce and Tyquan Thornton. You can easily pick up his auto for \$20 or less on eBay. 
