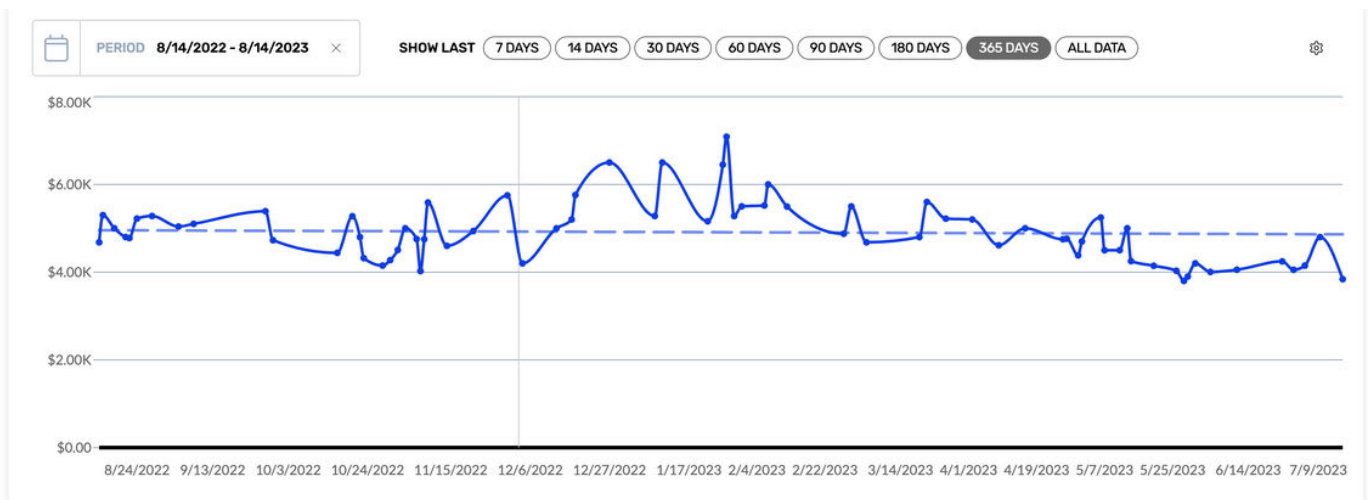

Ep 95 Buys of The Week

Alexander Ovechkin: 2005 Upper Deck Young Guns #443 PSA 10

Starting off this week's buy recommendations is the NHL's active GOAT, Alexander Ovechkin. For those of you that don't regularly follow hockey, Ovechkin is just 73 goals away from becoming the NHL's all-time scoring leader. If we look at his career scoring averages, Ovechkin has scored .61 goals per game, meaning the historic left wing is on pace to break the record within the next 12-18 months. We can use LeBron James and his own record-setting scenario as a perfect marker to evaluate how to optimize profits gains here. What we learned from James is that if you bought in prior to him setting the record, you were given a short-lived window as hype grew and James took the crown to fully maximize margins, so it is important to stay up to date and ready to list when the opportunity comes. Pair this blatant growth indicator with the fact that the card has dropped roughly 50% in the last 6 months, and this is a sure-fire way to make some serious profits for those willing to invest a larger amount of upfront capital.



Jordan Poole: 2019 Optic Base #169 PSA 10

It's basketball buying season, and our first NBA selection on this week's buy list is none other than the previously acclaimed Third Splash Brother, Jordan Poole. While Poole had a rocky finish to his tenure with the Golden State Warriors, he has an undeniable amount of skill and the ability to get hot at any moment. Sending Poole to Washington to team up with the savvy Tyus Jones and athletic wing Kyle Kuzma gives him a chance to shine as a primary shooting guard with less pressure to immediately succeed. Look for Poole to continue to mature and throw out several impressive performances that will each give flippers an opportunity to sell for profits. His 2019 Optic Base is selling astonishingly for under twenty dollars. We believe this to be an absolute steal for a player that can catch fire and give you 30-40 points any given night.

Darius Garland: 2019 Prizm Silver #288 PSA 10

Garland is one of the of our favorite young guards in the league, pairing an exceptional feel for the game with a wide array of scoring and playmaking moves. Garland's 2019 Prizm Silver in PSA 10 is currently trading at just \$90, down 18.2% over just the last 60 days. We expect Garland to have a strong bounceback from an otherwise lethargic NBA playoffs debut as he continues to mature and find his role in the back-court tandem of himself and Donovan Mitchell. Stock up on Garland now before he starts making weekly SportsCenter Top 10 appearances, and look to sell as soon as the hype returns and he makes himself an obvious choice for his second All-Star Game appearance in as many years.

Rashod Bateman: Contenders Rookie Ticket Auto Variation #113 Raw

Rounding off the week's buy recommendations is Rashod Bateman and his 2021 Contenders Rookie Ticket Auto. This card provides collectors with a low price point for a high value sleeper, as raw options are trading around \$10. In turn, flippers can stock up on Bateman with low risk and virtually no floor downside. Bateman was averaging a ridiculous 19 yards per catch through 5 games before being sidelined for the year with a left foot injury. With the Ravens' addition of Odell Beckham Jr, Bateman should have a portion of the defensive focus removed from him while a healthy Lamar Jackson looks to lead Baltimore deep into the playoffs. Pick Bateman up now and be prepared to sell as soon as he posts flashy numbers resulting in value spikes!
