Ep 95 Sells of The Week

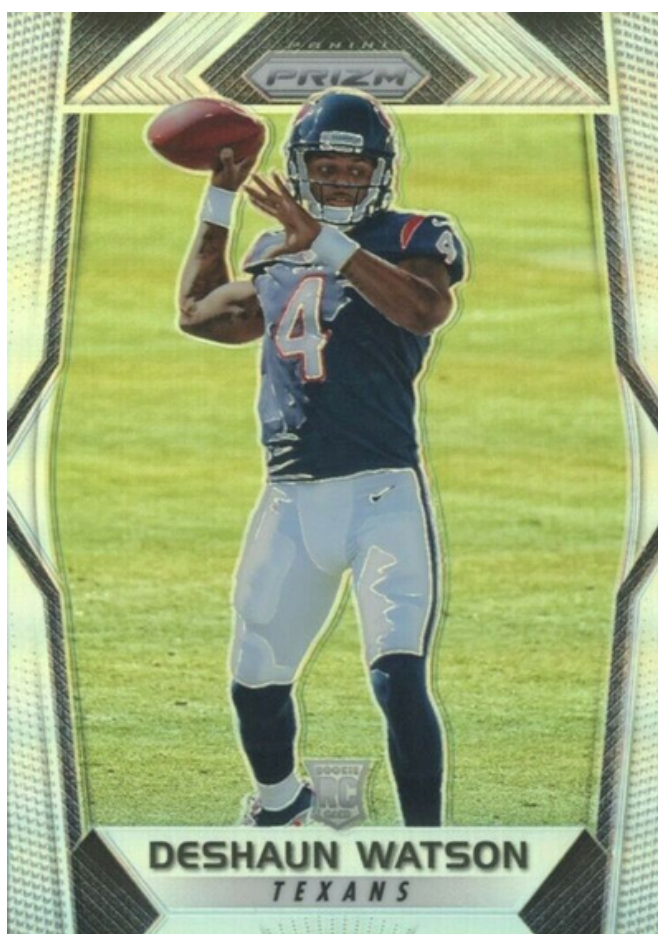
Corbin Carroll: Bowman Draft Chrome (1st) #BDC-125 PSA 10

Our first sell recommendation this week is Diamondbacks Outfielder Corbin Carroll. Carroll has had a remarkably impressive rookie campaign, and is currently pacing to win the National League Rookie of The Year award. For those who picked up Carroll in the prior months where we pitched him, list now, taking your profits and avoiding taking on any unnecessary risk. Carroll's 2019 Bowman Draft Chrome 1st in PSA 10 is up \$26.11 over the last 6 months, meaning those who purchased then can lock in profits of 35.3%.



Deshaun Watson: 2017 Prizm Base Silver PSA 10

Even though Watson was mentioned on the Sports Card Strategy Show as a buy by guest co-host Duke Dodson of Graybo's, we researched it and actually believe now is a much better time to off-load it and reinvest into cards mentioned in our Buys articles. Watson's 2017 Prizm Silver Base PSA 10 is up 75% over the last 6 months, making now an opportune time to dump him and lock in profits without having to wait on Deshaun to have a standout season.



Elly De La Cruz: 2022 Bowman Chrome Prospects (1st) #BCP-50 PSA 10

If you're still holding on to Elly De La Cruz, now is the time to get rid of him! Elly's cards have reached the peak of their value and are quickly cooling off and returning to reasonable numbers. The Reds are going nowhere, and De La Cruz valuations will continue to decline similarly to Julio Rodriguez did last year. His 2022 Bowman Chrome Prospects is already down 42% the last 30 days. Buy him back in the spring for massive discounts.



Dorian Thompson-Robinson: 2022 Bowman Chrome University Auto Refractor (1st) PSA 10:

Thompson's card pricing is currently receiving what we believe to be unwarranted levels of respect over the last week or so. Thompson played in both the league-opening HOF game and the Browns' preseason Week 2 narrow loss to the Commanders, performing well and lending his name credence as potentially being the best backup option for Deshaun Watson in Cleveland. However, it is important to note that Robinson threw just 2 touchdowns combined in those two games, playing against primarily 3rd and 4th string players. His Bowman Chrome University 1st Auto Refractors were previously selling around the \$10 price range, and now jumped all the way to the \$60-75 range. His hype train will not sustain itself as we lead into the regular season. The NFL preseason is an ideal time to get rid of your flier picks that perform well, so if you're holding Thompson-Robinson, list now and sell before his brief exponential card rise ends.
