SPORTS CARD SELL ALERT: JORDAN LAWLAR CALLED UP

The Arizona Diamondbacks have officially called up our 7th ranked top baseball card investment play. Lawlar, a 6-foot-2 infielder prospect, has proven to be a solid hitter in the minors, tallying 20 home runs and 67 runs batted in this season while posting a .278 average. Lawlar was given the call the same day he posted his first multi-homer game for the Reno Aces, making September 6th a day to remember for the talented prospect.

Jordan Lawlar's cards have seen a blanket of growth across the board, meaning those of you that have been holding him in your inventory over the last couple of months should have seen strong margin growth. His 2021 Bowman Draft 1st Sapphire Edition in PSA 10 has spiked a healthy 86.3% over the last 30 days, jumping from \$75 to \$140. Lawlar will be able to retain his rookie status being called up this late in the year, but now is still the time to get his cards listed to lock in on profits, yet investors should still be aware of him returning to our recommending buy list next season if he is relegated and his cards see a dip. If you're holding any of his Bowman Chrome 1sts, including the cards below, we recommend you get them listed ASAP:

2021 Bowman Draft 1st Sapphire Edition PSA 10 (Up 86.3% last 30 days)

2021 Bowman Draft Chrome 1st Raw (Up 340% last 30 days, though this number will only prove to be as impressive as a jump to those who made bulk plays here as the card went from \$1.25 to \$5.50 over this time period)

2021 Bowman Draft 1st Chrome Sky Blue Refractor PSA 10 (Up 51.5% last 30 days)

2021 Bowman Draft Chrome DP Auto PSA 10 (Up 15.8% last 30 days)
